

## 2006 Safety 'N Kids Traffic Workshop Presenter/Topic Submission Form

### Dear Safety 'N Kids Registrants and Friends:

Workshop presentations may include but not limited to Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety, Crossing Guards, Video Enforcement Around Schools and Minor Citation Diversion Program. Please send in your written submission with the application, keeping these guidelines in mind:

#### Substance of submission:

1. What issue or problem were you trying to solve or address?
2. What countermeasures were implemented?
3. How effective was the program or initiative?
4. What lessons did your Community learn from the experience?
5. Give brief history of program or initiative.
6. Include which topic applies to your submission (such as but not limited to Vehicle Transportation, Pedcycle Transportation, Traffic Engineering, Pedestrian Transportation, Community, Law Enforcement, Statistics and New Laws, Funding and Grants).

#### Notification and other stipulations:

1. Submissions due by August 20, 2006.
2. A Safety N' Kids representative will contact you by September 1, 2006.
3. Submission of a presenter and their program synopsis or topic does not guarantee selection to the Summit.
4. You will be required to pay your own travel expenses and discounted registration fee.

#### Format of submission:

1. Include your name, organization, address, phone, fax, and email on the form. Please attach a separate sheet of paper if you need additional space.
2. A short biography for Summit program.
3. All workshop synopsis and/or handouts are to be submitted electronically with submission. Handouts to be in English and Spanish. If unable to provide translation, contact Safety 'N Kids.
4. Format of submission should be in MSWord, PDF(non-fixed) and Excel files.
